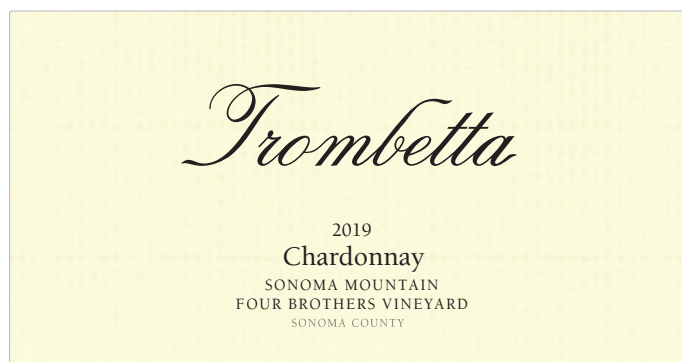


Trombetta

GROWING SEASON

Long moderate summer turned into a more normal near perfect growing year.

WINEMAKING

WINEMAKER

Erica Stancliff

Night hand-harvested grapes

Immediately pressed whole cluster, overnight tank settled

Fermented with native yeast

100% Native malolactic fermentation in barrels

Aged 8 months on lees in French oak barrels (30% new, 70% neutral), stirred every 10 days

Unfined and unfiltered
